Dr. Luh is now a Food Technologist at the University of California Agricultural Experiment Station, Davis, California. He received a B.S. degree in Chemistry from Chiao Tung University, and an M.S. in Food Science and Ph.D. in Agricultural Chemistry from the University of California, Berkeley.

Dr. Luh specializes in fruit and vegetable processing, nutritive value and storage stability of processed foods, and food chemistry and packaging of foods. Dr. Luh is also one of the founders of CAFS, and served as its first president.
